Type of Work

Drivers

Main responsibility is to drive trucks and haul loads to oilfield sites.

- Class 1 with Air Brakes Endorsement required
- Must have clean abstract
- Accurate record and log keeping
- Must follow all provincial and federal regulations
- Winch tractor experience
- Driver safety training an asset
- Ability to pay attention to detail
- Ability to problem-solve and think or respond to emergencies quickly
- Should be physically fit
- Must be able to pass drug and alcohol tests
- Must have all safety tickets, including TDG, WHMIS, H₂S and First Aid

Pilot Drivers & Hotshot Drivers

- Must have Class 5 Driver's Licence
- Must have all safety tickets, including TDG, WHMIS, H₂S and First Aid
- Able to problem-solve and respond to changing situations/quickly
- Must have successfully completed Pilot Driver's Course

Swampers

Help drivers load and unload trucks.

- Should be physically fit
- Must pass drug and alcohol tests
- Perform truck upkeep and maintenance duties
- Ability to communicate well
- Good attention to detail
- Able to problem-solve and respond to changing situations/quickly
- Must have all safety tickets, including TDG, WHMIS, H₂S and First Aid

Dispatcher

Dispatch trucks

- Oilfield dispatching experience a definite asset
- Excellent communication and people skills
- Ability to pay attention to detail
- Able to problem-solve and think or respond to changing situations/emergencies quickly
- Computer literate
- Ability to work independently

Welders

Responsible for general welding repairs and fabrication

- Must have Journeyman Ticket from an accredited training institution (such as NAIT, Lakeland College)
- Read and interpret blueprints or welding process specifications
- Operate manual or semi-automatic welding equipment
- Operate manual or semi-automatic flame-cutting equipment
- Operate brazing and soldering equipment
- Operate metal shaping machines such as brakes, shears and other metal straightening and bending machines
- Repair worn parts of metal products by welding on extra layers

Mechanics

Service and repair trucks and trailers

- Journeyman certification is an asset, but will hire and train apprentices
- Heavy duty experience with oilfield trucking
- Should be equipped with personal hand tools
- Ability to communicate with a variety of different people
- High standard of attention to detail
- May be required to supervise apprentices
- Responsible for maintaining shop and work area
- Remote repair may be required

Safety Officer

Responsible for safety training and compliance with all safety regulations

- Administers/arranges all safety training
- Provides all in-house safety training and safety meetings on a regular basis
- Knowledgeable about all occupational healthy and safety regulations (provincial and federal)
- Administration and general duties under Health & Safety requirements
- Must have Safety Officer training through an accredited institution

Hours of Work

Hours of work are unpredictable and employees are expected to be on-call 24/7.

Pay and Benefits

The company pays highly competitive wages, typically \$18 - \$45 an hour, depending upon qualifications and experience.

There is a comprehensive benefits package, paid overtime, a safe, friendly work environment, and opportunities to learn from experienced team members.
